#### কোর্সটির গুরুত্ব ও উদ্দেশ্য :

রবীন্দ্র যুগের উপন্যাসিকদের মধ্যে যে ত্রায়ী বন্দোপাধ্যায় আমাদের সমৃদ্ধ করেছেন তাঁরা প্রায় সকলেই উপন্যাস রচনায় যথেষ্ট কৃতিত্ব প্রদর্শন করলেও তাঁদের মধ্যে জনপ্রিয়তা ও সংখ্যাধিক্যের বিচারে তারাশঙ্কর বন্দ্যোপাধ্যায়(১৮৯৮-১৯৭১)ছিলেনঅগ্রগণ্য। বস্তুত তিনি অপর দুই বন্দ্যোপাধ্যায়ের (বিভূতিভূষণ বন্দ্যোপাধ্যায় ও মানিক বন্দ্যোপাধ্যায়) মত বিষয়ের অভিনবত্ব তে স্বতন্ত্র ধারার পথিক হলেও বঙ্কিমচন্দ্র ও শরৎচন্দ্রের ধারাকেও তিনি সমানভাবেই পুষ্পষ্ট করেছেন। অল্প সময়ের জন্য জীবিকা হিসেবে তারাশঙ্কর চাকুরী বা ব্যবসার সাথে যুক্ত থাকলেও জীবনের একটি বড় অংশ তিনি বিশুদ্ধ সাহিত্যসেবা করে গেছেন। রবীন্দ্রনাথ ব্যতীত অন্য কোন সাহিত্যিক ইতিপূর্বে সাহিত্যধারাকে জীবন সাধনার অঙ্গ রূপে এভাবে গ্রহণ করেননি তারাশঙ্কর প্রধানত উপন্যাসিক রূপে খ্যাতি লাভ করলেও ছোটগল্পকবিতানাটকসাহিত্যেরপ্রায়প্রতিটিধারাকেইতিনিস্পর্শকরেগেছেন।

ক্ষয়ইঝু জমিদার পরিবারের সন্তান তারাশঙ্কর সে যুগের যে পরিবেশে জন্মগ্রহণ করেছিলেন এবং বিভিন্ন সূত্রে যে পরিবেশ ও সমাজ ব্যবস্থার সঙ্গে পরিচিত হবার সুযোগ লাভ করেছিলেন তার সাহিত্য সাধনার মধ্যে সেই যুগ ও সমাজেরবিশ্বস্ত ও তথ্য নির্ভরসমাজ চিত্র অঙ্কিত হয়েছে আমাদের এই স্বল্প সময়ের পাঠক্রমের মূল উদ্দেশ্য-



উনবিংশ শতাব্দীর শ্রেষ্ঠ বাঙালি কবি ও নাট্যকার তথা বাংলা সাহিত্যেরনবজাগরণেরপ্রধান পথিকৃৎ ছিলেন মাইকেল মধুসূদন দত্ত। প্রাচ্য -পাশ্চাত্য উভয়ের প্রভাবকে আন্তীকরণ করে সাহিত্যের আঙ্গিক ও বিষয়ে তাঁর স্বকীয় চিন্তার প্রতিফলন এবং সৃজন প্রয়াস বাংলা সাহিত্য ভান্ডার কে দান করেছে অভূতপূর্ব মর্যাদা ও সৌন্দর্য ; তাঁর সমগ্র জীবন ও সাহিত্যে এক বাঁধন ছাড়া বিদ্রোহী মানসিকতার পরিচয় মেলে, বাংলা সাহিত্যে প্রথম সফল ঐতিহাসিক ট্রাজেডি নাটক রচনা, প্রথম সার্থক শ্রেষ্ঠ সাহিত্যিক মহাকাব্য ও পত্র কাব্য এবংবাংলা ভাষায় সনেটেরব্যবহারেওমধুকবিরঅবদানঅনস্বীকার্য। অমিত্রাক্ষর ছন্দের জনক মধুসূদনদত্তও এখনো পর্যন্ত অদ্বিতীয় ব্যক্তিত্ব।তাঁররচিত নাটক, কাহিনী কাব্য, মহাকাব্য সবকিছুর মধ্যে নবজাগরণের পরিচয় সুস্পষ্ট,মধুসূদনের সাহিত্যের মধ্যেই প্রথম রেনেসাঁসের প্রভাবে সার্বিকভাবে ব্যক্তিস্বাতন্ত্রবাদ ওনারী জাগরণের চিত্র বিশ্বস্ততার সঙ্গে প্রতিফলিত হয়েছে।বলাভালো মধুসদনের হাত ধরেই বাংলা সাহিত্য আধুনিকতায়প্রবেশ করে এগিয়ে চলেছে।

কোনো কোনো পাঠক, সমালোচক এমন ধারণা পোষণ করেন যে মধুকবিকে তার সমূহ আবেগ উপলব্ধি সহ ধরতে চাইলে অবশ্যই সনেটকে অবলম্বন করতে হবে তাঁদের চিন্তায় মাইকেলের কবিতা নির্মাণ কৌশল, জগত জীবন সম্বন্ধে তার অনুভব বাংলাদেশের প্রকৃতির মনোরম শোভাও মাটির সংস্কৃতি ও ঐতিহ্যের বিস্তৃত চেতনা র সৃষ্টির বিষয় বৈচিত্রগীতিসুষমা এবং আত্ম ভাবনিষ্ঠ সব কিছুর সাক্ষাৎ মিলবে, বাংলা সাহিত্যের উন্নততর সমৃদ্ধি বিকাশের প্রতি তিনি ছিলেন অত্যন্ত শ্রদ্ধাশীল। কাজেই মধুসূদন দত্তসাহিত্য প্রেমিকের কাছে গর্বের কবি।তাঁর মত সৃজনশীল ও সাহসী ব্যক্তি সমাজেদুর্লভ, তাঁর জীবনবোধ আর আধুনিকতা আজও আমাদের পাথেয়। তাই মধুকবির মতো সাহিত্যিকের জীবন ও সাহিত্য নিয়েবিস্তারিত আলোচনানিঃসন্দেহে শিক্ষার্থীদের জ্ঞানের পরিধি বিস্তৃতকরতেসহায়কহবেই।
