- * 30% of Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 3rd and 4th Semester(2nd Year).
- * 40% Questions in a paper are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 5th and 6thSemester(3rd Year).
